

## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

**9:30 a.m. Core Class** - We have childcare/classes for all kids 0-5th grade during this time. Please check in at the Children's Desk.

**10:30 a.m. Worship Service** - Ages 0-Kindergarten should be checked in and taken to their class prior to the service. 1st-3rd graders should be checked in prior to the service as well. They will join you for the music worship time before being dismissed to their class.

**6:00-7:30 p.m. Wednesdays** - Childcare is provided for ages 0-2 in the nursery. Ages 3-Kindergarten will meet in the 4 & 5's room, where they will be taught truths from the Believe study in a way that they can understand.
